What are the principal parts of the Mass? (6 marks)
3. Why must we hope in God? (2 marks)  
Give two examples from the New Testament where Our Lord rewarded those who trusted in Him. (4 marks)
4. (a) For a sin to be mortal, three conditions are necessary.  
Explain each condition. (6 marks)  
(b) How do we obtain pardon for our sins? (3 marks)  
(c) Write out an act of contrition suitable for confession. (3 marks)
5. (a) What arrangement is best for ownership of property?  
Give reasons for your answer. (4 marks)  
(b) What have you to say about—
  - (i) Borrowing and not returning?
  - (ii) Damaging public property?
  - (iii) A boy who dodges payment of bus fares?
  - (iv) The workman who said, "Take it easy, chum, it's the boss's time"? (2 marks each)
6. Give three examples from the Gospel in which Our Lord showed that He Himself respected the authority of others. (6 marks)  
Show the need for authority in (a) the family, (b) the school, and (c) the Church. (6 marks)
